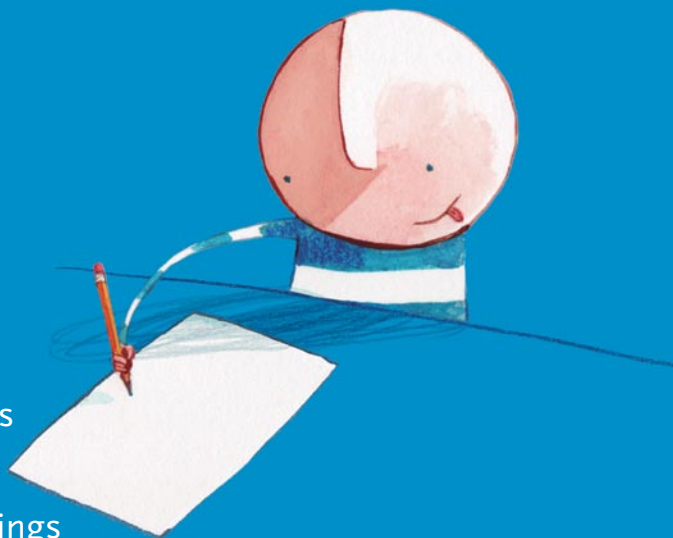
FAMILY TRAIL
