Learning objectives for KS1 and KS2

- to compare and contrast key features of the two portraits.
- to record observations using a range of methods.
- to draw conclusions about why the portraits are different in certain aspects (KS2).



This session can be delivered in 1 hour

For Key Stage 1 and 2, you could use these sheets to assist with comparing the portraits. Children could complete the column for each portrait and then compare and contrast the columns (same or different). The sheets could be used with the following options:



1. tick
2. draw
3. write key words or phrases
4. colour
5. click on symbols using ICT
