# British canvas, stretcher and panel suppliers' marks. Part 3a, Daler Board Company

This guide surveys suppliers' marks and labels on the reverse of picture supports. This part is devoted to the Daler Board Company, Wareham, Dorset, established in 1946, trading as Daler-Rowney Ltd from 1985. In view of the significant number of labels and marks now located for this business, this new part of the guide has been separated from Part 12: England.

For the history of this business, see the database, <u>British artists' suppliers</u>, <u>1650-1950</u>. Measurements, given where known, are approximate and may vary according to the trimming of a label. Square brackets are used to indicate indistinct or missing lettering in transcripts, with readings sometimes based on other examples. See also the notes at the end of this guide.






