

Opening hours and practical information

The National Portrait Gallery is open from Saturday to Wednesday 10 until 6 and on Thursdays and Fridays until 9 pm. Entry to the building is free of charge along with the Permanent Collection, although there are ticket prices for special exhibitions that go on throughout the year, and the prices may vary. Disabled visitors are entitled to visit the Gallery at the concessionary rates and their carers are admitted free of charge. The telephone number for the Gallery is 0207 306 0055.
